PERSONAL CONTRIBUTIONS TO "VFT-PAC" ARE NOT DEDUCTIBLE AS CHARITABLE CONTRIBUTIONS FOR FEDERAL INCOME TAX PURPOSES. YOUR CONTRIBUTION MUST BE BY A PERSONAL CHECK (OR COMPANY CHECK FROM A SOLE PROPRIETORSHIP), OR PERSONAL CREDIT CARD. CORPORATE CHECKS AND CORPORATE CREDIT CARDS ARE PROHIBITED UNDER FEDERAL LAW. AN INDIVIDUAL IS FREE TO CONTRIBUTE MORE THAN ONCE — BUT MAY NOT CONTRIBUTE MORE THAN \$5,000 PER CALENDAR YEAR TO A PAC. FEDERAL LAW REQUIRES THAT THE VOICE FOR TREES PAC REPORT THE FULL NAME, ADDRESS, OCCUPATION AND THE COMPANY NAME OF EACH INDIVIDUAL WHOSE CONTRIBUTIONS AGGREGATE IN EXCESS OF \$200 IN A CALENDAR YEAR. A CORPORATION MAY ONLY GIVE ONE TRADE ASSOCIATION PER CALENDAR YEAR PERMISSION TO SOLICIT THEIR RESTRICTED CLASS.
